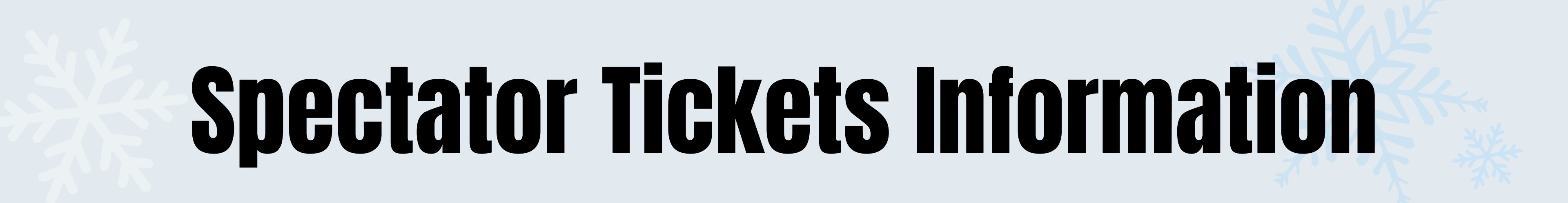

Spectator Tickets Information

Spectator tickets for all events will go on sale from **1st September 2026**.

All spectator tickets must be purchased through our ticketing partner, SportsThread. Please note that SportsThread applies an additional booking fee to all ticket purchases.

A limited number of tickets will be available online for each event. We strongly recommend purchasing tickets in advance to avoid disappointment.

Tickets will only be available to purchase on the door if capacity allows and tickets remain available. We cannot guarantee that tickets will be available on the day of the event.

Clubs wishing to purchase tickets in bulk for athletes, families, or supporters can still do so via SportsThread.

Entering / Administration For Competitions

A £200 deposit is required at the time of registration to secure your place at an event. Each routine must be registered and assigned to a division. If athlete details or final divisions are not yet confirmed, a holding division can be selected and updated later. As many events sell out quickly, we strongly recommend registering all intended routines at the time of booking, as only assigned routines will be guaranteed a place if an event reaches capacity. Additional routines may be added later, subject to availability.

Entries close once capacity is reached and may therefore close before the advertised early bird deadline. Registration will close 4 weeks before the event, at which point all team rosters, divisions, attending coaches, and final balances must be submitted and paid. A £25 per routine admin fee will apply for division or athlete roster changes made after this deadline (excluding injury-related changes).

Initial running orders will be released shortly after registration closes, with a 2-week window for amendment requests. A final running order will be issued by the weekend before the event.

Running orders are shared with head coaches only.

A Coaches Information email will be sent approximately one week before each event, containing venue-specific details and important updates to share with athletes and supporters.

Arrival Times

We can't stress enough that the door opening times are the earliest opportunity that your programme can enter a venue. We are bound by contracts with our venues in regard to times that we can open the doors and allow everyone in. This also applies to spectators arriving for later sessions. We are unable to allow spectators into an earlier session, therefore we recommend they don't arrive earlier than the doors opening times for that session.

Seating

Seats are for spectators only. We kindly ask that bags are kept stored on the floor (not on a seat) and that athletes use the space around the competition floor for their seating. Here, they are able to watch the competition and cheer on their peers. We would really appreciate you communicating this information to your athletes and spectators so they know what to expect.

Scoresheets

Score sheets are sent automatically via Regchamp once the judges have completed their sections. Remember, these are sent electronically, so will depend on the internet connection at the venue.

A Score query form will be available for you to fill in on Regchamp – the head judge will review your query, action and add notes, before setting it to reviewed – prior to the awards ceremony taking place.



Etiquette

We appreciate that competitions can be a stressful and emotional time, and we understand how important these events are for athletes, coaches and supporters. However, all participants are expected to demonstrate respect, good sportsmanship and professionalism at all times. ICE has a zero-tolerance approach to discrimination, bullying, harassment, and verbal or physical abuse towards staff, athletes, coaches, officials, or spectators. All athletes and spectators remain the responsibility of the programme coach or owner.

Where conduct or sportsmanship is deemed unacceptable, ICE reserves the right to issue deductions, request individuals to leave the venue, or, in very serious cases, disqualify teams from competition. Programmes may also be asked to leave the event where behaviour towards staff or others is considered inappropriate.

Our aim is to provide a competitive, positive and enjoyable experience for everyone involved. We continue to celebrate outstanding sportsmanship through our Spirit Awards and are proud of the incredible team spirit shown across programmes each season. We look forward to seeing that positivity continue throughout the season ahead.
